12 year German boy mobilizes support to help the planet



More than thirteen hundred policy makers, scientists, energy experts and journalists gathered here in Bonn this week. They were attending Deutsche Welle's annual Global Media Forum which this year focussed on the role of the media in communicating issues related to climate change.

One of the youngest guests was Felix Finkbeiner from Bavaria, who's just 12 years old. He's the driving force behind a movement called Plant for the Planet which he set up at the age of nine.
