Girona (Europa Press) .- The Princes of Asturias and **Girona** , Felipe de Borbon and WIN Letizia Ortiz , on Tuesday presided over the fourth meeting of the board of the Prince of Girona (FPdGi) in Science and Technology Park of the University of Girona (UdG),

where he will address the main lines have to keep the institution in the coming months.

More than 1,000 attendees

The celebration of the second edition of the Forum **Boost** , which will take place Wednesday at the Auditorio de Girona, will feature active princes and host over 1,000 attendees. The event aims to unite the experience and talent to turn the best ideas on values and social return, thus during the day there will be opportunities to exchange experiences and knowledge among young professionals established and active.

The forum aims to consolidate

as agora for debate on how to promote the environment and the tool to promote entrepreneurship among young people in different fields of social, business, scientific, academic and culture-sports. In a year has gone from 17 to 23 speakers, have dubbed the parallel activities during the day of the Forum, four to eight, has increased the number of attendees to a thousand-half younger than 30 years, but has kept the budget of the first edition, 490,000 euros.

Among the 23 speakers

included the opening talk by Wendy Kopp, co-founder and CEO of Teach For America and Teach For All, a global reference network in 18 countries that seeks to break the vicious cycle of poverty through education, and Time magazine in 2010 defined Kopp as one of the 100 most influential people in the world.
